It is understood the deviations from and the extra to the Specification were made by special arrangement, and that the Admiralty Contract Department is aware of the facts.

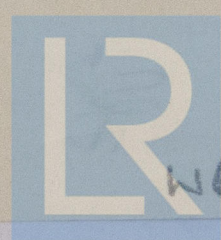
