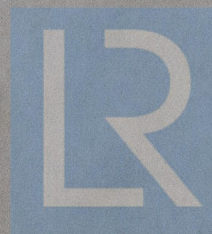
Dear Dr. Montgomerie,

With reference to the official letter dated 24th instant regarding the case of the s.s. "QUEEN LOUISE", which, like the s.s. "COYLET" belonging to the same Owners, is being converted for the purpose of carrying petroleum in bulk in cylindrical tanks, the Chairman desires me to say that he will be glad if you will kindly give this case your personal attention and full consideration and report whether you are satisfied that the arrangements are thoroughly reliable and such as should be approved by the Society.
