
Survey 1st Entry

It would appear in view of the yard number that this is the vessel that was already planked, when plans were submitted for classification; the Surveyors should therefore be requested to state if they are correct in recommending the Special Survey mark.

The Surveyors should also state whether, before being planked, anything in the nature of the requirements of footnote b table I of the composite rules, had been carried out, and whether 2 thick strokes of planking are fitted at bilge or 3 as shown on approved plan.
