Dear Sirs,

With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.2 which became due at the end of September 1932 and has been partly held on the steamer "STAR OF ALEXANDRIA", I have to acquaint you that in view of the satisfactory examination held at Liverpool, the Committee have agreed to this vessel proceeding to a Bristol Channel port to load a non-perishable cargo for a Mediterranean port, where on arrival she will be broken up.

It is understood that the steamer is to proceed to an Italian port, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.

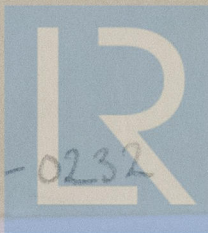
