I enclose herewith, for your information, a copy of a letter which has been received from Messrs. Watts, Watts & Co., Ltd., from which you will observe that objection is taken to the fee charged for the examination of the machinery of the s.s. "STAR OF ALEXANDRIA" at your port on the 16th instant.

With regard thereto I may say that it is considered in this Office that a fee of £2 for the machinery would have amply covered the services of the Surveyor in this instance.
