I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant respecting the case of the steamer "VIRGINIA MAVROELEN", and note that you have discussed the position with Messrs. Pnevmaticos, Rethymmis, Yannaghas, who have a financial interest in the vessel, and that it has been arranged ~~that~~ should the sale for breaking up not take place, all outstanding matters of survey and repairs will be dealt with before the vessel is put into commission again.

Although the above firm appear to be financially interested in the vessel, as they are not the registered Owners, it is considered desirable that you should inform the Owners that all necessary repairs must be effected before the vessel is again placed in commission.
