I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th. instant concerning the steamer "VIRGINIA MAVROLEON", and beg to state that as the vessel was loaded and the damage under water, the same was not seen, the fore peak not being opened up.

The Master stated that soundings had been taken daily since the stated accident, and that no leakage had been found.

The vessel is, in my opinion, in a satisfactory condition to proceed to Italy with cargo and thence to Piraeus for repairs.
