The Bordeaux Surveyor recently stated that this vessel had been in collision and had sustained some damage to the bow plating. As, on receipt of this information, the vessel was at Swansea, the Surveyors at that port were informed and requested to give the case attention.

The Swansea Surveyors now state they have been informed by the Master that the vessel is proceeding to Italy with a cargo, and thence to Piraeus where the damaged bow will be surveyed and repaired as required. Nothing will be done at the present time, and the vessel is now loading.

It is submitted the Piraeus Surveyors might be informed of the case and requested to give the matter attention on arrival of the vessel at their port.

The Swansea Surveyors might be asked to state whether in their opinion the vessel is in a satisfactory condition to proceed with cargo.
