I beg to inform you that Lloyd's Agent at La Rochelle has advised me that the steamer "VIRGINIA MAVROLEON" collided with an unknown object in the River Charente and sustained some damage to the bow plating about ten days ago.

The Master of the vessel declined Lloyd's Agent's offer of assistance and the vessel has since left for Barry Roads in ballast without being surveyed at La Rochelle.
