Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyor at St. John, N.B. on the steel Twin Screw Steamer "EMPRESS" which has been examined in dry dock at that port, from which it appears that the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.3, due last month, have been partly complied with. The Surveyor states that the Owners have requested an extension of time until September next in which to complete the survey, and this proposal has been agreed to. The Surveyor in forwarding his report desires to be informed as to whether or not it will be in order for him to complete the survey and asks whether an Exclusive Surveyor should attend.

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which I have addressed to the Surveyor on the subject and shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether, in view of the importance of the case, Mr. Dalton should be joined in the survey by one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors.
