Dear Mr. Leeuwenburg,

With reference to your letters of the 8th and 12th instant, regarding the cases of the two ex-German steamers "ALMKERK" and "OLDMERK", the circumstances have been again looked into, and with a view to the cases of these vessels being submitted to the Committee with a recommendation that the classes should be assigned subject to the freeboard being marked and verified, it is considered necessary that we should have an actual copy of the preliminary freeboard certificate, if one has been issued by the Dutch Committee, as suggested in your letter of the 3th instant.

I shall be much obliged if you can obtain this copy and send it along in an official letter.
