The engines and boilers were not opened at this time but so far as
can be judged from external examination and after reading the
previous condition report by Mr. H.P. Southwell and B.G. Oxford
am of opinion that this vessel's machinery is fit to run for a
further period of six months as from January 21st 1921. and at the
end of that time it is recommended the boilers should be opened up
and examined in their entirety.
