

UNDERTAKING CASE

S.S. "EBURNA"

This vessel became due for 2nd S.S.No.1 in 4,30. She has been laid up at Singapore, and the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

A letter has now been received from the Owners stating that the ship has been sold for breaking up purposes to purchasers at a Japanese port, and they desire a certificate to enable her to proceed with cargo from Singapore to Japan.

A cablegram has also been received from the Singapore Surveyor to the same effect.

It is submitted the Owners and the Singapore Surveyor be informed (the latter by cable) that provided the vessel be generally examined and found in a satisfactory condition she might be allowed to proceed with cargo to a port in Japan, as desired, on the definite understanding that she will be broken up on arrival.
