SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

DA ADAMS.—Port Ellen, Nov. 21.—Steam trawler *Ida Adams*, of Fleetwood, sunk at Frenchman Rocks, Islay. Crew safe. Bowmore, Nov. 21.—Trawler *Ida Adams* struck rock off Rinns of Islay Lighthouse and sank immediately. Crew saved.

IDA ADAMS.—Fleetwood, Nov. 21.—Eleven of the crew of the Fleetwood steam trawler *Ida Adams* reached the Scottish mainland after their vessel had struck the rocks early this morning. The trawler left here on Nov. 11 for a fishing voyage to the West Coast of Scotland. Late last night, homeward bound with a valuable cargo of fish, she struck a submerged rock in the Sound of Islay during fog. After making strenuous attempts to stem the rush of water, the crew took to their boat. The trawler was extensively damaged, and was almost submerged. A marine surveyor was dispatched to the scene of the stranding and will ascertain the prospects of salvage. "The Daily Telegraph" Correspondent of Nov. 20.

IDA ADAMS.—Glasgow, Nov. 24.—The crew of the trawler *Ida Adams*, of Fleetwood, who abandoned their vessel after she was wrecked on the west coast of Islay, reached the Scottish mainland safely. Shortly after landing on the beach the men saw their ship disappear stern first into deep water.—"The Glasgow Herald."
