H. With reference to your letter of the 10th July, 1930 enclosing the form of undertaking in respect of the steamer "PINCIO" which was laid up at Spezia, I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Genoa from which it appears that the vessel is still laid up there.

In this connexion I think it well to say that in the case of a vessel which is laid up indefinitely and where the Special Survey is overdue, the Committee require a general examination to be held by the Society's Surveyors twelve months after the expiration of the year of grace, and thereafter annually until the next Special Survey becomes due, with a view to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will kindly arrange for the requisite general examination to be made by the Society's Surveyors.
