Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that a cablegram has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Genoa, transmitting one received by them from you respecting the steamer "PINCIO", and in confirmation of the cable which I despatched to you to-day, I have to acquaint you that, as will be seen from the Register Book, the Second Special Survey No.3 of this vessel became due in June last, and should now be held.

I have to add that if the written consent of the present Owner is obtained, the Genoa Surveyors could be authorised to survey the vessel on behalf of the intending purchasers with a view to making recommendations as far as practicable as regards any necessary repairs, but the Committee would be unable to authorise them to make any estimate as to the cost that would be involved in carrying out the Special Survey or effecting any necessary repairs.


I enclose herewith a copy of the cable despatched to you, and have to say that your account has been debited with the cost thereof, viz:- £2.6.8.
