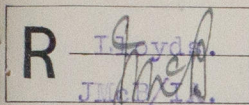

We beg to acknowledge yours of yesterday with reference to the boiler survey of the above vessel which was carried out in February of this year at Rotterdam, and note what you say with reference to the adjustment of the Safety Valve of the Port Boiler under steam. We were of opinion that this was dealt with prior to her departure from Rotterdam as our Superintendent was in the vessel until she arrived at Dover.
