We are in receipt of your letter of the 11th instant regarding the German-Classed Dutch Steamer "OOSTPLEIN", and note that it has been agreed that we shall issue a certificate on Report 10 as per specimen attached to your letter.

The survey will not be completed here, as vessel has been loading coal and coke and is not to drydock.

We have had an examination of the vessel except in way of D.B. tanks and found it generally in good condition.

In accordance with your letter, we shall give the Master of the vessel a certificate as indicated by you, and we shall forward a copy with our reports 8 & 9.
