With reference to my letter of the 30th ultimo relative to Danish vessels taken over by the Ministry of Shipping, I have to inform you that information has been received at this Office from the Technical Management of the Dutch steamer "OOSTPIEIN", at present classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, that it is desired that this vessel shall be submitted to a general examination in accordance with the instructions set forth in Circular 1764, with a view to a record of "Examined L.R.(with date)" being recorded in the Register Book, as arranged in the case of the Danish vessels referred to in the above letter.

I shall be glad if you will give the case of the "OOSTPIEIN" the necessary attention, and I may add that recommendations should be made to the Agents for this vessel, who, it is understood, have been instructed in the matter.
