SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

SHACKLETON.—Malin Head Wireless Station, Mar. 2.—Following received from British steam trawler Shackleton at 4 50 p.m., Mar. 1: Struck rocks west end of Rathlin Island. Want immediate assistance.
Belfast, Mar. 2.—Trawler Shackleton struck rocks westward of Rathlin Island yesterday afternoon and wanted immediate assistance of lifeboat which proceeded to her. Surveyor from Fleetwood passed through here this morning for the vessel where tug from the Clyde is due to arrive this afternoon.
Malin Head Wireless Station, Mar. 2.—British steam trawler Shackleton; British steamer Cara and steam trawlers Phrontis and Cuirass are standing by, but are unable to approach her until fog clears. Line on board from shore.
Malin Head Wireless Station, Mar. 2.—Following from British steam trawler Cuirass at 8 15 a.m.: Last man taken ashore in breeches buoy from steam trawler Shackleton. Now proceeding Red Bay to take survivors on board.
Malin Head Wireless Station, Mar. 2.—Following wireless message has been received from the master of the British steam trawler Cuirass at 3 50 p.m.: Steam trawler Shackleton wrecked Greenanbo Rocks. All crew saved.
SHACKLETON.—Belfast, Mar. 11.—Trawler Shackleton wrecked on Rathlin Head Mar 1: We understand that owing to changed weather conditions rendering salvage work impossible in the exposed position where vessel lies it has been decided to abandon attempts to save and that she may therefore be considered a total loss.—Lloyd's Agents.
