Dredge "Cyclope" - Advised as broken
adrift during towing on April 18th,
and considered as lost.

Messrs. Schneider & Co. have referred to us for
reply your letter to them dated 11th May, advising them that
the question of registering the circumstances of the loss
against the name of the vessel would, in all probability, be
discussed by your Committee at the next meeting, and request-
ing their prompt advice in the event of there being any
reason whatsoever against the immediate erasure of the above
vessel from your Register Book.

We have been in touch with our American associates,
Messrs. Bucyrus-Erie Company, and have received their cabled
authorisation to confirm on their behalf that, as far as
they are aware, there is no reason for deferring the erasure
of the dredge "CYCLOPE" from your Register Book.

We shall greatly appreciate it if you will kindly
advise us of your Committee's decision, in the event of this
question, as anticipated, being dealt with at the next meet-
ing.
