With reference to Your classing letter of the 29th ultimo, respecting the First Entry report No 4677 and with regard thereto I beg to inform You that the tanktop plating in the holds is. Strake next to middle line  $\frac{9 \text{ to } 8}{20}$  and the remainder  $\frac{8 \text{ to } 7}{20}$ .

The deck transverses and 2nd deck longitudinals are 8/20".

The size of upperdeck stringer angle is 5 x 5 x 11/20 and projects 9 ft through the bridge space at its fore end and 11 ft through the bridge space at its afterend, remainder of the stringer angle in bridge space 4 x 4 x 9/20"

Thickness upper deck sheerstrake is 0.50 as approved.
