

Dear Sir,

Under contract dated 20th July, 1933, we purchased the steamers "WESTERDIJK" and "EEMDIJK" presently lying at Dordrecht.

Messrs. Hall Angier & Co. Ltd., 91 Bishopsgate, London, have approached us to see if we would sell them the steamer "WESTERDIJK". We have replied that we are willing to ^{do} so at a price and on certain conditions. Messrs. Hall Angier require to know what it would cost to obtain a seaworthy certificate for a voyage to the East with cargo, and we have referred them to you. Perhaps if they get into communication with you on Monday, you will give them whatever information you can on the matter.

As a matter of fact our Mr. Douglas is presently in Rotterdam, and we expect him to be in London some time on Monday, but as we are not quite sure of his movements, we are writing you direct, although we will also be endeavouring to get into touch with Mr. Douglas on his arrival in London, and will advise him of the further negotiations now in progress with Messrs. Hall Angier.
