SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

CYRENA.—Wellington, May 25.—British steamer Cyrena got ashore entering port Wanganui; reported to be making water. Lighters alongside taking out cargo. Salvage steamer leaving for scene of casualty to render necessary assistance. Surveyor to Lloyd's Register called in.

CYRENA.—Wellington, May 28.—British steamer Cyrena: Divers report considerable damage, breaking amidships, tide flows in and out of vessel. Salvage of cargo is being attended to; 1400 case oil landed. Salvage steamer pumping out.

CYRENA.—Wellington, June 11.—British steamer Cyrena broken in two. Will be dismantled; gear will be sold by auction. Ship and cargo uninsured.
