Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 13th ultimo respecting the loss of the steamer "KILINDINI" and it is noted that a preliminary enquiry into the loss of the vessel has been opened, and that you were requested by the Port Officer to attend to give your depositions regarding any recent surveys held on the vessel.

It may be observed that the "KILINDINI" appears to be one of the Castle class trawlers of which many were built for war purposes and were so far as is known in every way satisfactory.

It is noted that in all probability you will be called upon to give evidence at the Official Court of Enquiry which will shortly be opened, and I shall be glad to receive a report thereof in due course.
