Reverting to my letter of the 4th instant respecting the proposed alterations for the conversion into cargo carrying vessels of the Admiralty Castle type Trawlers "JOHN GAUNTLETT" and "GRIFFITH GRIFFITH", I have to inform you that the proposed equipment has received consideration, and I am directed to state that in the circumstances the same will be approved.

At the same time, I have to state that as these vessels are to be converted into cargo carriers it will be necessary for a Freeboard to be assigned, and you should forward to this Office particulars of sheer, erections, hatchways etc., on form 11 B. for this purpose, together with the usual signed freeboard request form.
