Précis of particulars of Casualty

This trawler has been missing in Icelandic fishing waters since 7th February, 1925.

The Owners confirm this report.

In reply to an enquiry addressed to the Controller of Intelligence at Lloyd's, it appears that no application has yet been received to post the vessel "missing". Should such application not be received the vessel's name will be added to Lloyd's next list of "Untraced Vessels".

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

OVERDUE VESSELS.

London, Feb. 24.—H.M.S. Godetia has been dispatched from Lowestoft to search for the Hull trawlers SCAPA FLOW, FIELD MARSHAL ROBERTSON and other missing vessels in Icelandic waters.—"The Morning Post."

London, Feb. 25.—H.M.S. Harebell, the senior officer ship of the Fishery Protection Service, has left Hull to assist H.M.S. Godetia in the search for the two missing Hull trawlers SCAPA FLOW and FIELD MARSHAL ROBERTSON in Icelandic waters.

Reykjavik, Mar. 7.—The search for two missing British trawlers (FIELD MARSHAL ROBERTSON and SCAPA FLOW) has come to an end without result. The number of men involved on the missing British and Icelandic trawlers amounts to 67 Icelanders and 6 Englishmen. The cost of the search reaches a sum of between 750,000 and 1,000,000 kroner.—Reuter.

OVERDUE VESSELS.

London, Mar. 12.—After three weeks' vain search in Icelandic waters for the missing Hull trawlers FIELD MARSHAL ROBERTSON and SCAPA FLOW, and the Iceland trawler LEIFUR HEPPNI, the small cruisers Harebell and Godetia put in at Aberdeen this afternoon, when it was learned that all hope is definitely abandoned of saving any of the Icelandic and British fishermen who manned these vessels.
