With reference to your letter of the 3rd instant respecting the steamer "PARANA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report from the Society's Surveyors at Newport, from which it appears that the vessel has been examined in dry dock and the Boiler Survey held.

The Surveyors state that they have examined the propeller and outside fastenings, and that the wear down of the screw shaft is normal, and I may say that the Committee are agreeable to the examination of the screw shaft being postponed until the next dry-docking.


I have to add that the circulating pump has been placed in order, and the condition regarding this item has been removed from the vessel's class.
