
With reference to your letter of yesterday, and to your telephone message of this morning, regarding the proposed classification with this Society of the Steamer "NOWSHERA", I have the pleasure to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Belfast have been communicated with in order that plans shewing the scantlings and arrangements of the vessel and her machinery may be sent to this Office for examination.

It is noted that the steamer will dry dock at Falmouth on the 19th instant for survey, and when the scantlings and arrangements have been looked into the Society's Surveyors at that port will be fully advised.

In the meantime, the Society's Surveyors at Hull have been instructed to commence the survey for classification in so far as the bunker spaces are concerned when the "NOWSHERA" arrives at their port on Monday next.
