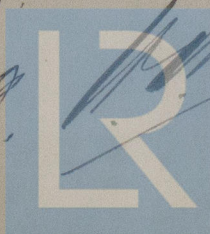

In reply to enquiry the Plymouth Surveyor states that the vessel is laid up at Dartmouth.
