With reference to the classification in the City's Register Book of your steamer "HOGARTH", I am pleased to acquaint you that to complete the special survey the following remains to be done, viz:-

"Vessel to be placed in drydock, bottom and rudder cleaned and examined, chain locker to examine, and anchors and cable to be ranged and examined. No.2 tank top coaming angle in way of manhole starboard side to be riveted. No.1 hold starboard side aft one shell rivet to renew. Port shell plate A.5, B.5 & C.5 from forward and 6 floors and 5 intercostals in No.1 double bottom tank, starboard shell plates C.5 and 4 floors and 3 intercostals in No.1 double bottom tank, to be dealt with"

"All sea cocks and valves and under water fittings to be examined"
