Sir,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your favor of 15th inst. with the classification Certificates, which have been given to the Builders and receipted for. They will have them to the Owners Agent here. The freeboard verification of 7' 2" has already been forwarded and is doubtless in your possession ere this. An amended report was sent forward containing corrections of some errors and omissions in the original first entry sent, of which the Principal Surveyor at New York had advised me, and which I regret had been found, and I trust the amended report sent was found correct.

Shortly after the vessel was finished I was seized with a very bad attack of grippe, and left in a very weak and debilitated condition. Consequently my health at that time made it impossible for me to fill out the report at that time. An opportunity offered to go North and I went to Vancouver and Victoria, expecting to be gone about ten days, trusting the change would be beneficial, but I was gone 20 days and did not begin to improve until I had been back a week. I am glad to say that my health has been thoroughly restored. I am exceedingly sorry that the delay occurred and trust, under the circumstances, that the Committee will excuse the delay.


