Repairs due to account of Damage (the cause of which must be stated) should be separated from Repairs due to other causes; besides being detailed in the body of the report, should be summarised in the form shown below. Whenever the removal of Anchors or Chains is reported, the particulars should be clearly stated in the space provided on back of this form. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.

placed on slipway on account of damage stated to have been caused (1) fouling cable of steam drier "Melinka" and (2) grounding in the bilge on Jan 20. 1925 - Feb 2. 1925.  
Damage found:- Stem frame grooved at bottom & rivets in stem frame bent. The rivets in keel in slack. Bottom scummed & painted off.  
Done. Stem frame where grooved built up by electric welding and rivets. Slack rivets on aloft renewed, several landing caulked and bottom cleaned and coated.
