Nature of Survey

Dimensions :- 138.33' x 23.62' x 13.5'.  
Scantling Nos. :- 37.12 & 5134.81.  
Proportions :- Length = 10.24 depths.

This vessel was built in 1918 under the survey of the British Corporation to plans mutually approved by this Society and the British Corporation for the "Mersey" class trawlers.

Reports have now been received from the Ipswich Surveyors, at whose port the vessel has been under survey with a view to classification, giving particulars of scantlings etc. which are generally in accordance with those approved.


The vessel has been examined in dry dock, the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules have been complied with, a Special Survey No.3 carried out and minor repairs effected.

The workmanship appears to be satisfactory.
