Classification with this Society is now desired by the Owners. The machinery, including the screw shaft, has now been examined throughout by the Ipswich Surveyors and the engines tried under steam; and a satisfactory report has been forwarded by them.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible for THE RECORD.

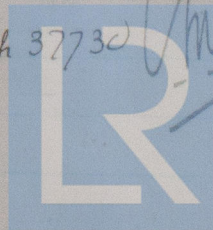
