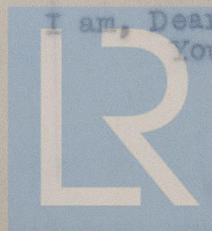
You will observe that at the foot of the letter the Owners have been advised as to the position in regard to the other vessels of their fleet.
