With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "WEAR" I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No.2 became due on this vessel in August, 1933 but has not yet been completed.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting today together with a report from the Society's Newcastle Surveyors on an examination of part of the machinery, and it appears that the vessel is still laid up.

In the circumstances and as the year of grace allowed for the Special Survey expired last August, I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, whilst she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office in due course.
