The 2nd Special Survey No 1 became due in June, 1934.

The Kobe Surveyors stated in a communication dated 30th July, they were informed by the Owners that the vessel would be laid up following her arrival in Japan during August, & would subsequently be broken up under the ship standard improvement subsidy plan.

In a further communication received from the Kobe Surveyors, dated 14th November, it is stated that the vessel is now being broken up in the Osaka district.
