This steamer, which was loaded with wheat, was reported to be in distress on 21st April with a list of 30 degrees in lat 41.32 N. long. 61.41 W.; and a later report from the S.S. 'Homerie' stated that the vessel sank at 11.55 a.m.

RAIFUKU MARU.—Camperdown (N.S.) Wireless Station, Apr. 21.—At 5 15 a.m. Japanese steamer Raifuku Maru in lat. 41 32 N., long. 61 41 W. (? 61 41 W.), ship inclined 30 degrees, loaded wheat, helpless.

— New York, Apr. 21.  
— Radio from British steamer Homerie this a.m. reports: Steamer Raifuku Maru, Boston for Hamburg, in distress in lat. 41 32 N., long. 61 41 W., reported to have list 30 deg. Crew probably in boats. Homerie 70 miles away proceeding her assistance. British steamer King Alexander also in vicinity.

— Camperdown (N.S.) Wireless Station, Apr. 21.—9 a.m., British steamer Homerie 45 miles from steamer Raifuku Maru, proceeding to give assistance.

— Camperdown (N.S.) Wireless Station, Apr. 21.—Steamer Homerie reports: At 4 55 p.m. (G.M.T.) observed steamer Raifuku Maru sink in lat. 41 43 N., long. 61 39 W. Unable to save any lives.

RAIFUKU MARU.—New York, Apr. 21.  
—Steamer Homerie radios: Steamer Raifuku Maru sank at 11 55 a.m. in lat. 41 43 N., long. 61 39 W. Regret unable to rescue crew; proceeded voyage. Another report states 48 Raifuku Maru's crew lost.
