Précis of particulars of Casualty

This trawler is reported to have stranded on the shoals of Sable Island, off the coast of Nova Scotia, on 19th July, and on 21st July she was stated to be a total loss.

No reply has yet been received from the Owner to the usual casualty notice.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

LABRADOR. — Sable Island, July 19. — Following from trawler Labrador: Ashore north-east Bar, Sable Island. Position dangerous.

St. Pierre (Miq.), July 19. — French steam trawler Labrador ashore Sable Island. Is being lightened; endeavouring to refloat.

LABRADOR. — Sable Island Wireless Station, July 19. — Following from American steamer WEST COHAS: WEST COHAS aground three east of eastern light, Sable Island.

St. Pierre (Miq.), July 19. — American steamer WEST COHAS got ashore at Sable Island while assisting French steam trawler Labrador.

Halifax (N.S.), July 19. — American steamer WEST COHAS and the French trawler Labrador are stranded on the shoals of Sable Island, off the Nova Scotia coast. Lifeboat crews which are attempting to rescue the crews are being kept off by the heavy seas running. There is dense fog. — Reuter.

LABRADOR. — St. Pierre (Miq.), July 21. — French trawler Labrador reported total loss. Crew saved.
