

S.S. "WITIAZ".

The boiler in question was built under special survey in 1915 by Messrs. Dunsmuir & Jackson, Ltd., and in 1916 it was fitted in the Power House of Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. Ltd.

The Belfast Surveyors now state that it is intended to fit the boiler on board the S.S. "WITIAZ", as an additional main boiler, in lieu of the original donkey boiler; further, that the boiler has been examined throughout and, together with its mountings, has been found in efficient condition.

The plan of the boiler was originally approved for a working pressure of 185 lbs. per square inch, and it is desired to use a pressure of 170 lbs., which is that assigned to the machinery of the vessel.

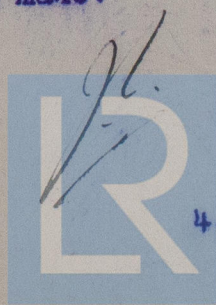
It is submitted that the proposal to fit this boiler in the above vessel might be approved and a working pressure of 170 lbs. per square inch be assigned, when the boiler has been satisfactorily fitted on board.

Further, as Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. state that the original certificate of test of the boiler cannot be traced, a duplicate certificate might be issued in this instance and the usual charge for same be made.
