have been discussed in this Office with Mr. Long Missrs Workman Clark & Co., who are to alterations.

that provided the cargo doors be constructed as plans, the same will merit approval.

from Mr. Scott that the alterations are to be in the superintendence of Mr. Master of Belfast, no lower deck in the holds is to be constructed trans amidsides, fitted at alternate frames.

of the beams being reduced towards the ends decreases. Woodplanks both and space, are to be laid on them considerably less than would be required for an inch, but if they are designed to carry a fruit cargo at 125 cubic feet to the ton, the shores are, unassociated with deck plating, fitted at if of 6+3+3+34 web, and .475 flange, centre line, and in ways of the hatchways, and to the side framing by beam knees, would be the square inch, which is not considered to be circumstances.

informed the Belfast Surveyors he requested to inform you, to, and the Owners representatives, that it is proposed that none but fruit cargoes, or other light density be carried on the new lower deck in the holds, not take exception to the beams being fitted of the wood, at alternate frames, provided they be adequately secured to the side framing by beam knees, and kept in place by strapping and tie plates, not be recorded in the Register Book.
