Précis of particulars of Casualty

This steamer stranded near Kinkasan during a fog on 18th May; salvage stated to be hopeless, vessel broken in two

In reply to a casualty notice the Owners state that the vessel was abandoned to the Underwriters on 9th June, and had passed into the hands of the Salvage Company. The Kobe Surveyors state they are informed by the Salvage Co. that she is a total loss.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

SPAIN MARU.—London, May 19. — The following cable has been received from Tokio, dated May 19: Steamer Spain Maru stranded near Hanabuchi Saki, taken, May 18. Sending assistance.

SPAIN MARU.—Yokohama, May 20. — Japanese steamer Spain Maru went ashore during a thick fog on May 18 near Kinkasan. Expect serious damage. — Lloyd's Agents.

SPAIN MARU.—London, May 21. — The following cable has been received from Tokio, dated May 21: Steamer Spain Maru: Position of steamer lat. 33 19 N., long. 141 33 E., rocky bottom. Starboard side 1 port side 5 fathoms, hold No. 1, hold No. 2, hold No. 3, engine-room leaking heavily, listing port side 15 deg., head down.

SPAIN MARU.—London, May 29. — The following is a copy of a cable received from Tokio, dated May 29: Steamer Spain Maru: Salvage operations very difficult, condition worse; fear total loss.

SPAIN MARU.—London, June 12. — The following cable has been received from Tokio, dated June 11: Steamer Spain Maru reported broken amidships June 8.

SPAIN MARU.—London, June 16. — Tokio advises steamer Spain Maru broken in two; salvors declared vessel total loss; salvage proceeds expected.

SPAIN MARU.—London, June 17. — Steamer Spain Maru: A cable received from Tokio to-day states salvage is hopeless.
