Kawasaki Kisen Kabushiki Kaisha, that she was abandoned by them to the Underwriters on June 9th and is now in the possession of the Teikoku Salvage Company. The Teikoku Salvage Co. inform us that she is a total loss and cannot be reconstructed, although the vessel's register has not yet been cancelled officially by the Marine Bureau.
