This ex-German steamer was built by Mr. Henry Koch at Lubeck in 1912 and was classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

She is a sister vessel to the S.S. "CANO" ex "MELILLA" to which vessel the class 100A "with freeboard" was assigned by the Committee on the 15th ultimo.

The scantlings as indicated on the First Entry Report, now received from the Hamburg Surveyors, have been examined, and found to be the same or equivalent to those approved for the sister ship.

It is accordingly submitted that the vessel is worthy of the favourable consideration of the Committee for the class 100A- "with freeboard".
