With regard to the steamer RABAT I have to state, that one of the Owners superintendents, who was over here, considered, that the Bulwark-plate, which was increased in thickness at front of Bridge, compensated for the doubling required to the sheer strake at Well, as indicated on the plan, and on his return to London has apparently drawn his Owners attention to this, as he said he would do, the question of fitting the doubling being postponed until a reply was received from the Owners.

As there is no increase in the thickness of the Outside plating in way of the Well, the doubling plate as indicated on the plan is being fitted as arranged with a Mr Carr who is over here at present, Therefore cabled you today as follows:-
