
I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Sourabaya intimating that he has been informed that the steamer "TJIPONDOK" has been sold to Mr. Sakamoto Seiichi of Osaka, but it is not known whether it is intended to break the vessel up or trade her. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will furnish me with any information you may be able to obtain on this point.

I should add that a proposal to have the 2nd Special Survey No.2 held sometime within the year of grace has been agreed to by the Committee, some indented shell plating on the port side requires to be dealt with at the Owners convenience, to complete the Boiler Survey for the record BS 4,34 both after main boilers require to be examined and all the safety valves to be adjusted, and the sternbush requires to be examined or renewed before the end of January 1935.
