The Copenhagen Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

On account of damage, cause not stated, temporary repairs have been effected to shell plate D9 on starboard side.

The Surveyors recommend a bower anchor of proper weight and test be placed on board to replace one missing and shell plate D9 starboard side be permanently repaired at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 3.32, subject as recommended.
