

Equipment of anchors for Messrs. Palmer's S.B. & Iron Co's No. 764,  
S.S. "NEW YORK".

This vessel requires an equipment of bower anchors, as follows:-

The anchors supplied to the vessel, however, are as follows:-

1st Bower anchor	54.	2.	11	ex stock
2nd " "	52.	3.	7	"
3rd " "	46.	2.	18	"

Collective weight 154. 0. 8, which is 1 cwt. 1 qr.  
20 lbs., or <sup>only</sup> .96%, less than the Rule requirements.

It may be pointed out that the stream and kedg anchors are somewhat heavier than required by the Rules, so that the total outfit of anchors is only 2 qrs. 6 lbs. less than the Rule requirements, and the chain cable is 12 cwts. 0 qrs. 9 lbs. in excess of the requirements.

The Newcastle Surveyors **state** that the vessel is to sail on Saturday, and the Builders will be glad to have the Committee's approval of the outfit supplied.

It is submitted that, under the circumstances, in view of the slight deficiency of the outfit of anchors below the requirements of Table 22, the anchors supplied in this instance might receive the Committee's approval.
