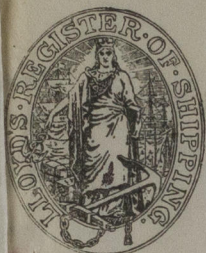

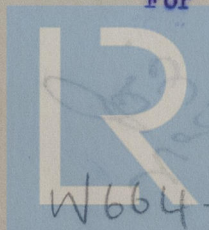
ANSWER.

Reference is made to the letter of the Board of Directors dated January 14, 1921, regarding the proposed lease of the property at 1234 Main Street, New York City.
